

## Dry Fertilizer Applications Over Corn Increasing

Applications of dry fertilizer over the top of corn have grown in popularity due to the agronomy department's acquisition of two Venturi row crop dry spreaders over the last year. Applications can be made on corn up to 24" tall with a maximum of 125 units at a time.

Call any of our agronomy locations to schedule a dry fertilizer application, and you could see this piece of equipment in your fields soon.



## Sedgwick Grain Storage Expansion



Kanza Cooperative Association will soon have an additional 750,000 bushels of grain storage at the Sedgwick location. This project adds three 250,000 bushel concrete bins to the site.

Phase one of construction began in December of 2017 with the demolition of the dilapidated dry fertilizer shed that occupied the site. The second phase of the project began in January of this year with the erection of the three concrete structures. The third concrete structure was completed in May.

The final phase is in process and includes installing ground equipment. The intent is to have the expanded storage capacity available for use by late summer in time for fall harvest.
